

## ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION ORDER TO VACATE

To: William Wong

"the Owner"

And To: All Occupant(s) of the following Housing premises: 4328 73 Street NW – Trailer.

**RE:** Those housing premises located in Calgary, Alberta and municipally described as:

4328 73 Street NW - Trailer.

WHEREAS I, an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

**AND WHEREAS** such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. The measured temperature inside the trailer home was 7.6°C.
- b. There is no plumbed supply of potable water to the trailer home.
- c. There is no sewage disposal system connected to the trailer home.

**AND WHEREAS** such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Housing Regulation, Alberta Regulation 173/99, and the Minimum Housing and Health Standards exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. The measured temperature inside the trailer home was 7.6°C. This is in contravention of section 8(a)(b) of the Minimum Housing and Health Standards which states that "all heating facilities within a housing premises are able to be properly installed and maintained in a good working condition, and be capable of safely and adequately heating all habitable rooms, bathrooms, and toilet rooms within the building to a temperature of at least 22°C (71°F)".
- b. There is no plumbed supply of potable water to the trailer home. This is a contravention of section IV(9) of the Minimum Housing and Health Standards which states that: Every building used in whole or in part, as housing premises must be supplied with a potable water supply of sufficient volume, pressure and temperature to serve the needs of the inhabitants.
- c. There is no sewage disposal system connected to the trailer home. This is a contravention of section IV(6) of the Minimum Housing and Health Standards which states that: Every housing premises shall be connected to the public sewage system, or to an approved private sewage disposal system.

**AND WHEREAS**, by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **Unfit for Human Habitation**.

## NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

- 1. That the occupants vacate the above noted premises on or before November 30, 2023.
- 2. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
  - a. Ensure that the heating facilities can maintain a temperature of at least 22°C in the trailer home.
  - b. Provide an approved plumbed in and consistent source of hot and cold potable running water to the trailer home.
  - c. Connect the trailer home to an approved sewage disposal system.
- 3. That until such time as the work referred to above is completed to the satisfaction of an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services; the above noted premises shall remain vacant and secure from unauthorized entry.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
